A meeting of the Garrison Diversion Conservancy District Municipal, Rural & Industrial (MR&I) Committee was held on August 15, 2022. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Kaiser at 10:30 a.m.

The meeting was recorded to assist with compilation of the minutes.

READING OF THE MINUTES

Motion by Director Kassian to dispense with the reading of the May 18, 2022, MR&I Committee minutes and approve them as distributed. Second by Director Walter. Upon voice vote, motion carried.

RETURN OF GRANT FUNDS

Chairperson Kaiser referred to the email received from the Greater Ramsey Water District indicating they would be returning grant funds awarded from the Water Supply Assistance Grant Program in the amount of \$10,000 for Bill Wakefield. Due to rising water levels at Dry Lake/Devils Lake, the rural water line cannot be installed within the timeframe allowed.

CURRENT FUNDING TABLE & PROJECT REVIEW

Ms. Mooridian reviewed the list of outstanding Water Supply Assistance Grant Program projects year to date, which total \$87,800. Add in the projects approved in 2022, along with return funds, and the total increases to \$162,313 less expenditures and unused return funds of \$46,133, which leaves a balance remaining of \$116,180. A copy of the list is attached to these minutes as Annex I.

COMPLETED PROJECTS

Ms. Mooridian reviewed the list of completed Water Supply Assistance Grant Program projects. Projects approved in 2021 total \$81,795. Total expenditures from June 21 to December 31, 2021, are \$41,530. Total grant funds returned are \$40,264. A copy of the list is attached to these minutes as Annex II.

REVIEW OF GRANT APPLICATION

Minimum Project Cost - - Chair Kaiser questioned the thoughts on implementing a minimum dollar amount to be awarded per project.

Extensive discussion ensued on this topic.

Motion by Director Walter to not implement a minimum grant award. Second by Director Blanchfield. Upon voice vote, motion carried.

REVIEW OF WATER SUPPLY ASSISTANCE GRANT APPLICATIONS

Rural Water Requests

Central Plains Water District

Keith and Jean Johnson are requesting \$10,000 through Central Plains Water District to install rural water at their farmstead located in Benson County. Total estimated project cost is \$35,000. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex III.

Tim Schmiess is requesting emergency assistance in the amount of \$2,242 through Central Plains Water District for a rural water hookup at his residence near Harvey. The total estimated project cost is \$6,983. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex IV.

Greater Ramsey Water District

Larry and Karen Beattie are requesting \$4,250 through Greater Ramsey Water District for a rural water hookup at their residence in Ramsey County. The total estimated project cost is \$11,000. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex V.

Tane Lacina is requesting \$5,550 through Greater Ramsey Water District for a rural water hookup for his livestock operation in Ramsey County. The total estimated project cost is \$13,600. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex VI.

McKenzie County Water Resource District

Lynn Heiser is requesting \$6,187.50 through McKenzie County Water Resource District for a rural water hookup for his livestock operation in McKenzie County. The total estimated project cost is \$14,875. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex VII.

North Prairie Regional Water District

Joann and DuWayne Hendrickson are requesting \$4,446.73 through North Prairie Regional Water District for a rural water hookup at their residence in Ward County. The total estimated project cost is \$6,893. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex VIII.

Dean Keller is requesting \$3,432.23 through North Prairie Regional Water District for a rural water hookup at his residence in Ward County. The total estimated project cost is \$4,864. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex IX.

Michael and Crystal Wing are requesting \$4,719.23 through North Prairie Regional Water District for a rural water hookup at their residence in Ward County. The total estimated project cost is \$7,438. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex X.

South Central Regional Water District

Tavi Leier is requesting \$1,351 through South Central Regional Water District for a rural water hookup at her residence in Burleigh County. The total estimated project cost is \$5,202. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex XI.

Southeast Water Users District

Andy Wolters is requesting \$8,475 through Southeast Water Users District for a rural water hookup at his residence in Richland County. The total estimated project cost is \$19,450. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex XII.

Consideration of Funding

Motion by Director Walter and second by Director Marquart to approve funding in the amount of \$43,904 for allocation to the following projects:

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$10,000 to Central Plains Water District for installation of 5,280 feet of pipeline to a residential home for Keith and Jean Johnson located in Benson County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$2,242 to Central Plains Water District for installation of a water pipeline to a residential home for Tim Schmiess located in Wells County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$4,250 to Greater Ramsey Water District for installation of a water pipeline, gate valve, and curb stop to a residential home for Larry and Karen Beattie located in Ramsey County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$5,550 to Greater Ramsey Water District for installation of a water pipeline, gate valve, curb stop and meter pit for livestock use for Tane Lacina located in Ramsey County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$6,188 to McKenzie County Water Resource District for installation of a water pipeline, two frost free hydrants and a 12,000-gallon stock tank for livestock use for Lynn Heiser in McKenzie County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$2,197 to North Prairie Regional Water District for installation of a water pipeline and curb stop to a residential home for Joann and DuWayne Hendrickson in Ward County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$1,182 to North Prairie Regional Water District for installation of a water pipeline and curb stop to a residential home for Dean Keller in Ward County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$2,469 to North Prairie Regional Water District for installation of a water pipeline and curb stop to a residential home for Michael and Crystal Wing in Ward County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$1,351 to South Central Regional Water District for installation of 240 feet of pipeline and meter pit for a residential home for Tavi Leier in Burleigh County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$8,475 to Southeast Water Users District for installation of a water pipeline to a residential home for Andy Wolters in Richland County.

Upon roll call vote, the following directors voted aye: Blanchfield, Kaiser, Kassian, Marquart, Rogers and Walter. Those voting nay: none. Motion carried.

FEDERAL MR&I PROGRAM

Construction Report - - Ms. Mooridian reviewed the 2022 MR&I expenditures as of August 31, which total \$9,667,790. Remaining approved federal MR&I funds are \$18,120,421. A copy of the report is attached to these minutes as Annex XIII.

Cooperative Agreement Update

Ms. Mooridian said the current Cooperative Agreement expires on September 30, 2022. Reclamation has assured Garrison Diversion the agreement will be extended for an additional five years, which we are still waiting on.

WATER PRO

Kimberly Cook, Communications Director, Garrison Diversion, informed the committee the National Rural Water Association (NRWA) is asking for messages to be shared about "Why Rural Water". Once all messages are compiled, the content will be used at the WaterPro Conference and throughout the year to promote rural water. She questioned whether the committee wishes to develop a message to share at the conference coming up in September.

The committee consensus was to prepare and submit a short message, including pictures and audio, to the NRWA.

OTHER BUSINESS

Chairperson Kaiser would like to find the appropriate avenue to spread the word to the small communities located within the Garrison Diversion Conservancy District about the Water Supply Assistance Grant Program and the benefits it provides.

Ms. Cook said there are various avenues where the grant is mentioned. Staff members will determine what other areas can be used to promote this grant program, to include sending a letter to city auditors and create an individual banner to be displayed at the different conferences.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Chairperson Kaiser adjourned the meeting at 11:28 a.m.

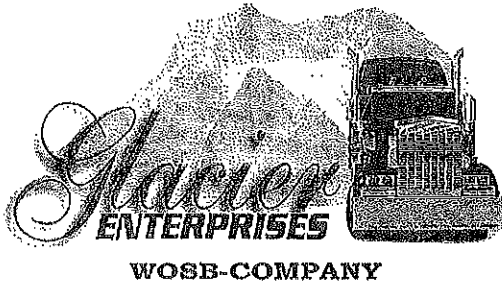
